
RE: PICK UP/DROP OFF TRAFFIC PATTERN

Dear Parents/Guardians:

During pick up and drop off, there is nothing more important than ensuring that everyone who is a member of our school community is safe. Your help as a parent/guardian is vital in guaranteeing this safety. Please review the below and we thank you for following our procedures.

The diagram on page 2 illustrates the traffic flow and the drop off zones. Key points to abide by:

- Oak Street is a *One-Way* street enforced by the Police Department during morning and afternoon drop off/pick up times. K-turns are <u>not</u> allowed on Oak Street.
- Families wishing to utilize the <u>"Kiss & Drop" zone</u> behind the school may enter the parking lot <u>from Newbury Place</u>. If you enter the school parking lot from Newbury Place, you must proceed to Oak Street to exit. K-turns are <u>not</u> permitted in the school parking lot. Please do not park in the Kiss & Drop zone.
 - If you pull down Newbury Place, you may turn around at the end of the block and drop your child off on the sidewalk along Newbury Place, adjacent to the softball field.



- Parking Spaces in the school parking lot are for STAFF MEMBERS ONLY; please do not park there. Unfortunately, our parking lot does not have an adequate amount of parking spaces and teachers already park on the street.
- Due to the Fire Lane being located in the parking lot adjacent to the cafeteria, NO vehicles (parent or staff) may park within the Fire Lane.
